Commissioners Present - Chairman Hummingbird, Commissioners Carter, and Wilson.

Staff Present – Sharon Swepston, and Fonda Gritts.

Meeting was called to order at 4:30 p.m. Quorum established with Chairman Hummingbird, Commissioners Carter and Wilson present.

The Commission began with agenda item #1 – Approval of Minutes – September 9, 2015. Commissioner Carter made a motion to approve the minutes. Commissioner Wilson seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Agenda item #2 – Monthly Reports-

Motor Vehicle: FY “15” 23.24% increase in revenue for gross revenue comparison for year to date. For the month of October 2015 compared to the month of October 2014 there is an increase of 12.52%.

Revenue and Taxation Division: FY “15” -19.02% decrease in Revenue and Taxation comparison year to date. Retail sales had an increase of 3.10% and alcohol tax was 6.02%. The decrease was in the cigarette and tobacco tax. For the month of October 2015 compared to the month of October 2014 there is an increase of 9.36%. Retail Sales was 16.69% increase compared

to October of 2014. Alcohol tax was 4.57% increase compared to October 2014.

Chairman Hummingbird made a motion to approve the monthly reports. Commissioner Carter seconded the motion. Motion carried.


Agenda #3 – Consideration, discussion, and possible approval regarding any matter not known about or which could not have reasonable been foreseen prior to the time of posting.
