## New Transit Services set to start in Washington County on Monday March 11, 2013.

Cherokee Nation has partnered with Cimarron Public Transit to provide Native Americans and tribal employees with low-cost transportation services in the Bartlesville and Washington County areas. This will be a curb-to-curb transportation service for access to jobs and other essential facilities. To schedule a ride, call Cimarron's dispatch office in Bartlesville at (918) 336-2233. Bus fares for eligible destinations are 50¢ one way and \$1.00 for round trip. Eligible destinations for Native Americans include employment, healthcare, and governmental facilities or the nearest financial institutions and grocery stores from the riders' point of pickup (Native American identification must be presented). Non-Native Americans who are tribal employees may utilize this service for employment purposes only (tribal ID badge must be presented).
