The Roads Department is in the process of updating its Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) as required by federal law. The TIP is the construction plan that details how the Department plans to spend its Indian Reservation Roads funding over the next five-year period. The Department has developed a list of projects for consideration based on the tribally approved Transportation Improvement Program Procedures and invites your comment on the following candidates:

The Department has held a series of community meetings for seven of the nine projects listed above because of their necessity for expanded rights-of-way in order to meet federal standards. In contrast, the proposed access road around the Talking Leaves Job Corps stands solely on tribal lands and thus its impact on the public is negligible. Likewise, the proposed Shady Grove Road project only needs resurfacing and a small amount of shoulder work and therefore its impact on the public is minimal as well. However, the Department invites public comment on all of the proposals listed above. The public comment period will end on July 8, 2011, at close of business.
