- Be engaged in a program of education and in good standing, with a GPA of not less than 2.5 on a 4 point scale.
- Applicants selected to serve on the TYC 24-25, will not be allowed to participate in other Cherokee Nation youth programs. simultaneously. Submit completed application by the deadline of 5 pm, CST, Wednesday, August 7, 2024.

To Whom It May Concern:

It is my pleasure to announce that Cherokee Nation is currently seeking applicants for the 2024-25 Cherokee National Tribal Youth Council (CNTYC).

The CNTYC was established with the endorsement of the Cherokee Nation Tribal Council by Resolution on October 14, 1989. The Tribal Council introduced establishing the CNTYC Act, it passed unanimously on

May 17, 2021. The purpose of the CNTYC is to promote mental and physical well being of tribal youth. The CNTYC will also play an advisory role to the Cherokee Nation, particularly when youth issues are being discussed. The goal of Cherokee Nation Education Services is to build leadership qualities in youth and prepare them for their futures. The CNTYC will play a vital role in ensuring that youth have a voice to those making decisions and policies that affect them. Councilors are expected to be leaders in their homes, schools and communities and will take part in community meetings and service projects. Councilors will also attend Cherokee Tribal Council meetings.

As illustrated on the map to the right, the red line indicates a division between the north and south districts; seven eligible applicants will be selected from the northern districts (9 thru 15) and nine eligible applicants will be selected from the southern districts (1 thru 8), and one At-Large from outside the districts. Your residence determines your District.

To be eligible for consideration for **one of the seventeen** seats open, on the CNTYC, the applicant must review and complete all steps found on the Application Eligibility, Duties & Check List found in this application packet.

The application must be received by 5 pm CST Wednesday, August 7, 2024 to be eligible for consideration. Email applications to youth-leadership@cherokee.org. Faxed applications will NOT be accepted -- No Exceptions. All applicants will receive notice when and if they are selected. Councilors will be selected in September 2024 and there will be an official swearing in ceremony to be held, in September 2024 (attendance is required pending safety guidelines.) Councilors will serve a one-year term beginning September 1, 2024 and ending August 15, 2025. Please contact youth-leadership@cherokee.org if you have questions or need further information.
