



## College Resource Center Honor Cord Program

### Introduction

The Cherokee Nation College Resource Center Honor Cord is available for current graduating high school seniors that are registered Cherokee Nation citizens. Students are eligible for an honor cord once per lifetime. Honor cords are provided to recognize Cherokee Nation citizens at high school graduation ceremonies.

Students may submit a complete application to [collegeresources@cherokee.org](mailto:collegeresources@cherokee.org). Students applying for this program need to meet the guidelines below.

### Guidelines

- A. The following items need to be included together to be considered:
  1. Completed Cherokee Nation Honor Cord application.
  2. A copy of the student's most recent high school transcript.
    - a. High school transcript can be official or unofficial (7 semesters).
- B. Student must be a registered citizen of the Cherokee Nation.
- C. Student must be attending high school.
- D. Student must have a permanent residency within the United States.
- E. Students are eligible for one honor cord, ONCE PER LIFETIME.
- F. Students must be classified as a graduating high school senior.

Application deadline for honor cords is March 30<sup>th</sup>.  
Any applications received after this date may not receive an honor cord in time for graduation.  
Honor cords will be mailed out by April 15, if application is received by March 30<sup>th</sup>.
