At each session we will be accepting information sheets and depending on the weather playing Cherokee Marbles, Stickball or Chunkey, working on Cultural Crafts, language, leadership skills or community service projects.

Snacks and all materials and supplies are furnished by Cherokee Nation Community Youth Development. There is no charge to participate in any of our youth activities.

We need a completed information sheet on each youth participant so if you have not completed and turned in an information sheet with the required documentation please bring your completed information sheets with the required documentation with you to the next scheduled activity. If you need an information sheet please contact Pam Bakke at 1-800-256-0671 ext. 5347 and one will be mailed to you or we will have information sheets at each activity.

Information sheets will be kept in a locked file cabinet in our offices and will only be used for addresses to send information about youth activities to the youth and in case of a HUD audit for verification we are working with housing resident and low-income Native American youth.

** Please remember any youth attending youth activities under the age of 5 must be accompanied by a parent or adult who will help supervise them and help them with their project. Projects are designed for youth ages 5 – 18, youth under 5 may not be able to complete all projects.**

** Anyone who is more than 30 minutes late may not be able to do the scheduled project as projects are designed to fit in the 1 1/2 hour time frame. If a youth comes to activities more than 30 minutes late they may do color sheets or puzzle sheets in place of the scheduled project if they will not have time to finish the project.**

** Any youth arriving late after snacks have been served or leaving early before snacks will not receive snacks.**

** All youth must clean up their area before they leave.**

** Once a youth leaves the activity building they must go home, for safety reasons they will not be allowed to run in and out.**

* * Activities may end early if all participants finish the projects earlier than the scheduled end time.* *
